CA Code of Regulations (CCR), Title 22, Section 65523 in part: The pool operator of every public pool open for use shall test the disinfection residual and pH of the public pool water a minimum of once per day. Shall maintain written daily record of all test results, equipment readings, calibrations, and corrective action taken at the pool site. Shall test heated pools' water temperature a minimum of once per day. Shall measure the cyanuric acid a minimum of once per month. Shall maintain a written record of routine maintenance and repairs to the public pool at the public pool site. Shall maintain data and records for at least two (2) years for inspection by the enforcing agent and shall submit all data and records to the enforcing agent upon the agent's request.
