- SUBJECT: Tule River Ambulance

The Tule River Indian Health Center has met all state and local requirements and will begin providing paramedic ambulance services on the Tule River Indian Reservation.

Beginning today, Tule River Ambulance will operate a minimum of one advanced life support (paramedic) ambulance on a 24/7 basis. The designated ambulance unit ID will be Medic-891. They have a second back-up vehicle that is designated as Medic-893, which is also a 4-wheel vehicle.
