CCEMSA is accepting applications for EMS Training Officer/Preceptor on an open continuous basis starting July 20, 2022.

CCEMSA EMS Training Officer/Preceptor shall be responsible for the field evaluation of Paramedics and participate in field internships of Paramedic students, from both Fresno County and West Hills paramedic training programs. Interested Paramedics, that meet the qualifications below, are encouraged to apply. Qualifications for EMS Training Officer/Preceptor:

- A Paramedic in good standing with **two years full-time** paramedic field experience, including the **previous year (full-time)** in Fresno, Kings, Madera, or Tulare Counties,
- Currently accredited in Fresno, Kings, Madera, or Tulare Counties,
- Recommendation from PLO emailed to jbuehler@fresnocountyca.gov,
- Successfully pass a review of past performance including field evaluations, patient contact report audit, and quality improvement reports,
- Successfully pass a written exam on CCEMSA Paramedic Treatment Protocols and Operational Policies with a minimum score of 80%,
- Successfully pass an oral interview with the EMS Training Coordinator.

The exam and interview will be scheduled by appointment only after receiving both application and employer recommendation.

Applicants selected as EMS Training Officer/Preceptor will be required to participate in training meeting CCR Title 22, Division 9, Chapter 4, Article 3 and CAAHEP standards.
