A new California state law regarding anti-entrapment drain covers or systems went into effect on January 1, 2010.

This law provides protection to prevent drowning and reduce the number of suction incidents, injuries & deaths.

The Fresno County Department of Public Health's Environmental Health Division is enforcing this new law.
