^{*}NOTE: For Title 17 reportable agents detected by Culture-independent Diagnostic Tests (CIDT), either the original specimen or a culture isolate may be submitted. Results from GN broth submissions may not be satisfactory. If the original specimen is submitted instead of an isolate, additional charges may accrue for additional work up to isolate the pathogen. Culture isolation of the pathogen detected by CIDT may not be successful.
