## Summary

From 2013 – 2022, suicide rates in Fresno County remain steady at about 10 per 100,000 residents. The tables and figures herein below display the various aspects of suicides among Fresno County residents.

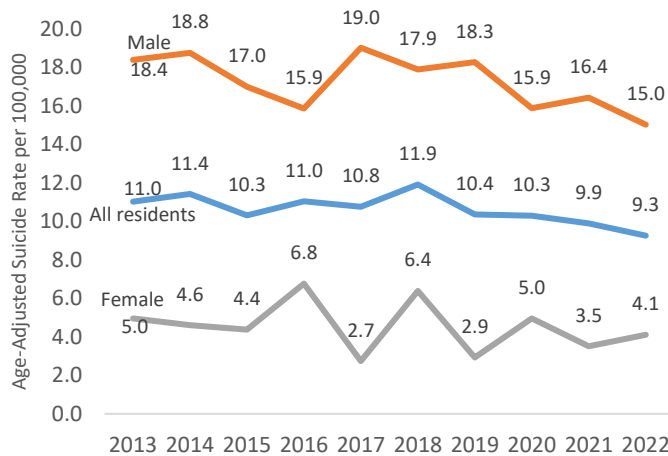

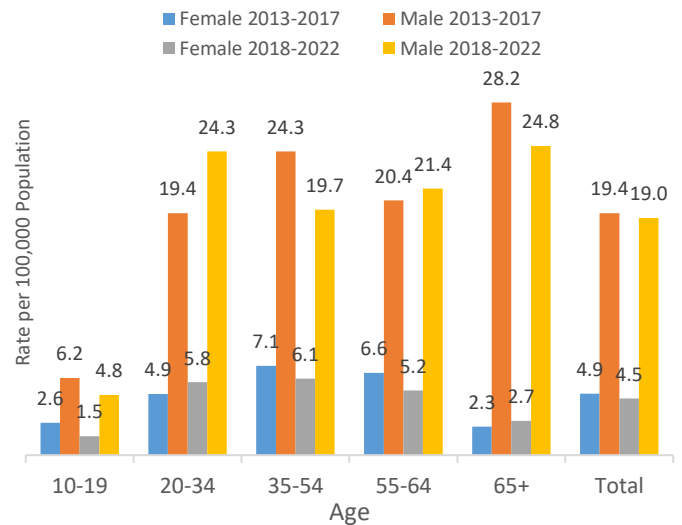
