



MCAH 2020 Infant Mortality

Summary of Results:

Infant Mortality is the death of an infant within the first year of life. The Infant Mortality Rate (IMR) is measured by the number of infant deaths for every 1,000 live births. It is a strong predictor of health and well-being and reflects the overall health of a community.

Similar to the state and national trend, Fresno County continues to observe decreases in the number of births within the last several years. The trend is observed both in the overall number of births as well as among race/ethnicity groups.

In 2020, 13,829 babies were born in Fresno County. Of those, 69 babies died within the first year of life, resulting in an infant mortality rate (IMR) of 5.0. This rate ranked among the highest in California where the IMR was 3.7 (CDC, Stats of the State of California). Fresno County surpasses Healthy People (HP) 2020's objective to bring the infant mortality rate to below 6.0. Among the major ethnic/racial groups, White, Asian, and Hispanic have exceeded HP 2020's goal. What's promising is the IMR appears to be lower than the previous year. It remains to be seen if the trend continues, however.

Infant mortality affects races/ethnicities in different ways as reflected in Table 1. Although Blacks accounted for only 5.2% of Fresno County's total births, they accounted for 15.9% of total infant deaths.

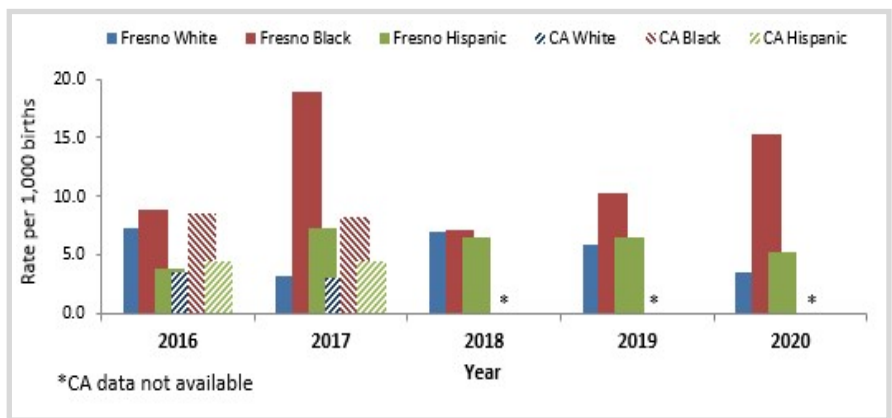
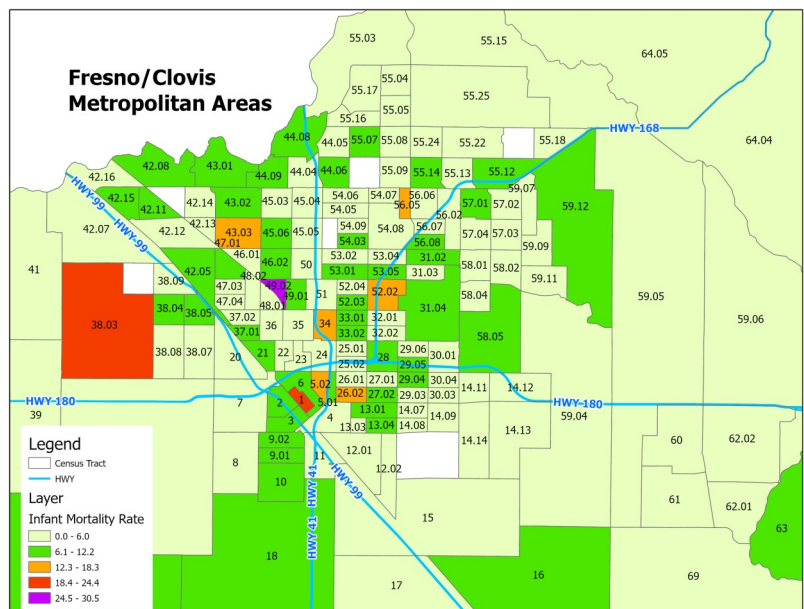


Figure 2. Infant Mortality Rate per 1,000 Live Births by Census Tract, 2016–2020

Within the metropolitan areas, infant mortality appears to be high along major corridors (Figure 2).

Figure 1. Infant Mortality Rate per 1,000 Live Births and Trend by Race/Ethnicity, County of Fresno vs California, 2016-2020
