Figure 1. Births by race/ethnicity, 2021

Figure 1 displays the proportions of birth in Fresno County by race/ethnicity in 2021. According to the Census Bureau at www.census.gov/quickfacts/fresnocounty-california, Fresno County's population by race/ethnicity in 2021 are: White, 27.2%; Black, 5.9%; Native Hawaiian and Other Pacific Islander, 0.3%; Asian, 11.6%; Other, 3.3%; and Hispanic, 54.7%.




Figure 2 displays the total number of births each year since 2010 in the County of Fresno with trendline. Although Fresno County's overall population has increased from 930,507 in 2010 to 1,013,581 in 2021 -- an increase in population of 8.9% -- the total birth among residents has decreased 13.5% during the same period ([U.S. Census Bureau QuickFacts: Fresno County, California](https://www.census.gov/quickfacts/fresnocounty-california), accessed 10 November 2022).

Figure 2. Births by year, 2011-2021


