A Summary of Deaths in Fresno County (2024)

Points of Interest:

Figure 1 displays the proportions of deaths in Fresno County by race/ethnicity in 2024. According to the Census Bureau at www.census.gov/quickfacts/fresnocounty-california, Fresno County's population by race/ethnicity in 2023* were: White, 26.4%; Black, 6.0%; American Indian/Alaska Native, 3.2%; Asian, 12.2%; Native Hawaiian and Other Pacific Islander, 0.3%; Other, 3.5%; and Hispanic, 54.9%.

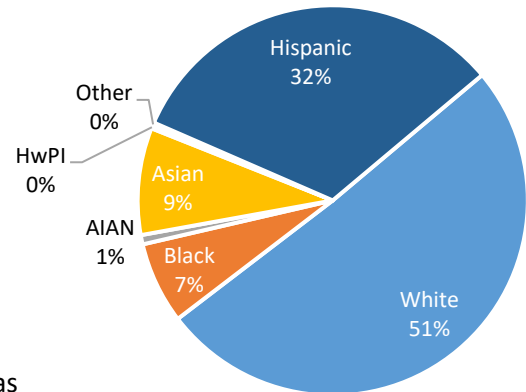


Figure 2. Deaths by year, 2014-2024

Figure 2 displays the total number of deaths each year since 2014 in the County of Fresno. The data should be interpreted with caution, as death counts from 2020 to 2022 were anomalies due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Figure 1. Deaths among Fresno County residents, 2024

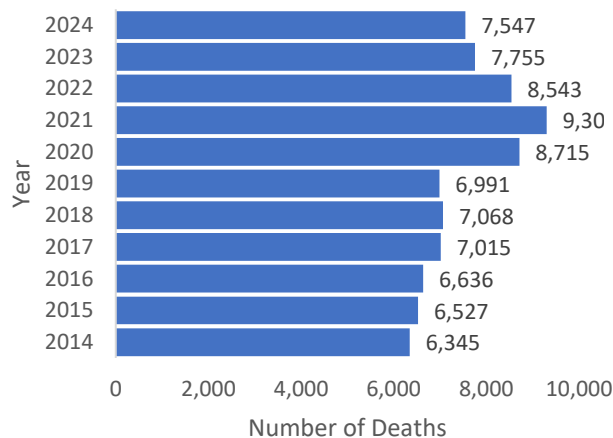


Figure 3. Leading Causes of Death, 2024

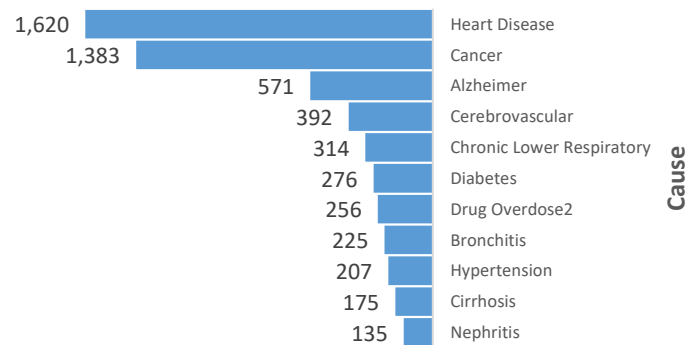
