Figure 1 displays the proportions of deaths in Fresno County by race/ethnicity in 2024. According to the Census Bureau at www.census.gov/quickfacts/fresnocounty-california, Fresno County's population by race/ethnicity in 2023* were: White, 26.4%; Black, 6.0%; American Indian/Alaska Native, 3.2%; Asian, 12.2%; Native Hawaiian and Other Pacific Islander, 0.3%; Other, 3.5%; and Hispanic, 54.9%.

Figure 2 displays the total number of deaths each year since 2014 in the County of Fresno. While Fresno County's overall population has increased from 930,450 in 2010 to 1,017,162 in 2023 -- an increase in population of 9.3% – the total deaths among residents has increased 31.0% during the same period (U.S. Census Bureau QuickFacts: Fresno County, California, accessed 26 February 2025).


