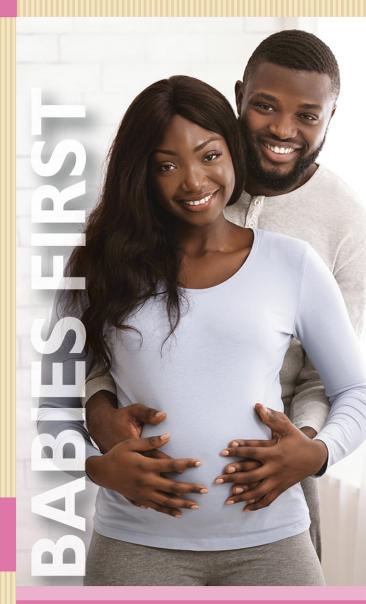

If you do not have insurance or a way to pay for prenatal care, you may qualify for Medi-Cal or other programs.



What is healthy for you and your family?

- See your doctor regularly
- Get dental care, visit your dentist at least once a year
- Exercise every day
- Do not smoke

- Get enough rest
- Take a vitamin with folic acid
- Eat healthy foods like fruits and vegetables
- Do not use drugs or drink alcohol

Remember moms and dads need to take care of themselves too.

Folic Acid is important!

It is a B vitamin that helps the body make new red blood cells for growth and repair. Taking folic acid may reduce the risk of birth defects.
