4467. (a) On and after January 1, 2018, and until December 31, 2023, any applicant for a local business license or equivalent instrument or permit, and from any applicant for the renewal of a business license or equivalent instrument or permit, shall pay an additional fee of four dollars (\$4) for that license, instrument or permit, which shall be collected by the city, county, or city and county that issued the license, instrument or permit.

Submit this business license application form with full payment. Please make your check or money order payable to **County of Fresno**. Do Not mail cash. A business license will be provided only after the application is approved by all necessary approving agencies (Sheriff, Health, and/or Public Works Departments) and the License fee is received. The expiration date for all business licenses is June 30, the last day of the county's fiscal year. A renewal application will be sent prior to the expiration date for the following fiscal year. It is important that you notify this office of any changes in the information or status of your business. **NOTE:** The holder of the business license is not entitled to carry on any business that does not comply with other applicable laws nor carry on any business in any building or on any premises situated in a zone or locality in violation of any law.

PLEASE READ – IMPORTANT UPDATE

Senate Bill 205 (2019) requires certain businesses to demonstrate enrollment in the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit program **when applying for or renewing a business license**. Applicants must determine if their business falls under regulated Standard Industrial Classification (SIC) codes. Please research your SIC code and NPDES requirements to ensure compliance with this law.

Only businesses assigned a Regulated SIC Code, as identified by the California State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB), must confirm their enrollment in the NPDES Stormwater Industrial General Permit (IGP). To meet SB 205 requirements, these businesses must provide proof of enrollment—by submitting one of the documents listed below.

Finding the SIC Code for the business and providing it with a new or renewal applications is required is the responsibility of the business license applicant.

6.04.030 - License—Fees—Prorating.

A.

All sums of money for licenses provided for in this title are due and payable in advance at the office of the county license collector, and all licenses, except as otherwise specifically provided, shall be issued to expire on June 30th; provided, that no license shall be issued to expire more than one year from the date of issuance and not less than the period for which the license fee is fixed. Each license issued shall state the name of the person to whom issued and the nature of the business, the location for which same is issued, the date of issuance, the license period for which issued, the amount received therefor, and refer to this title and be signed by the treasurer-tax collector. Each license shall expire at the time fixed in the license issued by the treasurer-tax collector.

B.

The periods of all monthly licenses shall begin on the first day of each calendar month, and the periods of all quarterly licenses shall begin on the first days of January, April, July and October, and, where a new license is issued after the beginning of any quarter, a pro rata deduction shall be made in the amount of the fee therefor for each whole calendar month that has expired since the beginning of such quarter up to the time when the licensed business was commenced.

C.

Applications for licenses under this title shall be made in writing and filed with the license collector. Each application shall be accompanied by a predetermined nonrefundable fee.

D.

Each license under this title shall be issued to a specific business or person and shall in no event be transferable from one person to another.
