A Summary of Births in Fresno County (2023)

Points of Interest:

Figure 1 displays the proportions of births in Fresno County by race/ethnicity in 2023. According to the Census Bureau at www.census.gov/quickfacts/fresnocounty-california, Fresno County's population by race/ethnicity in 2022* were: White, 26.7%; Black, 5.9%; American Indian/Alaska Native, 3.2%; Asian, 11.9%; Native Hawaiian and Other Pacific Islander, 0.3%; Other, 3.4%; and Hispanic, 55.0%.

Figure 1. Births by race/ethnicity, 2023




Figure 2 displays the total number of births each year since 2013 in the County of Fresno with trendline. Although Fresno County's overall population has increased from 930,450 in 2010 to 1,015,190 in 2022* -- an increase in population of 9.1% -- the total births among residents has decreased 15.7% during the same period ([U.S. Census Bureau QuickFacts: Fresno County, California](https://www.census.gov/quickfacts/fresnocounty-california), accessed 20 April 2023).

Figure 2. Births by year, 2013-2023


