


#### This Board's Constitutional Duty:

#### To Fairly Allocate Political Power in Fresno County. U.S. Constitution, Article 1, Section 2

### Creation of the Equity Coalition Map

- 1. Community of Interest (COI) Surveys Collected
  - a. Food Banks, Vaccination Clinics, Flea Markets, public events, and online.
- 2. Survey takers, redistricting meeting attendees and groups work with demographer to **create** map, learn about redistricting.
- 3. EMC members **attend** all county COI Input Sessions
- 4. Vet, refine and support the map.

- 2. **Compliance with Voting Rights Acts (VRA)**
- 3. Contiguity
- Communities of Interest (COI) 4.
- Geographic Integrity 5.
- 6. Easily Identifiable by Residents
- 7. Compactness (where it doesn't conflict with previous criteria)

No partisan favoritism or discrimination. (EMC Interpretation: No Incumbent Residence)






# Communities of Interest (COIs) Kept Whole:

- **COI:** Rural Westside made whole All rural towns and small communities West of Highway 41.
- **COI:** Westlands Water District and West Hills Community College District kept whole in District 1
- COI: Southeast Fresno County Rural Farmworker Communities, combined with urban residents in Southeast Fresno with similar demographics
- **COI:** Farmworkers as a strong community, traditionally overlooked.
- COI: Genuine North Fresno district, separates Clovis at Willow Ave border
- **COI: Clovis** anchors District 5, with new development, Mountain & Foothills
- **COI:** Preserves **District 3** as a coalition district in the central urban core
- **COI:** Respects boundaries of many diverse **Ethnic Communities** 
  - Hmong, African American, Punjabi & Latino.

## Voter Turnout


Ineffective VRA Districts can result when voter turnout is not balanced to account for historical disenfranchisement.

#### **EMC Submissions:**

Meets Constitutional Mandate to Fairly Allocate Political Power in Fresno County

Legitimately Creates 2 VRA District (All Effectiveness Metrics above 50%, Variance below 1%)

A True Community Map: Democratic, Inclusive and Partisan Blind

#### NDC and Public Map 101:

Incumbent Protection Maps

Variance for all NDC maps was higher than 2 percent (ineffective VRA)

Do Not Meet VRA Effectiveness Metrics.

Contradicts Protected Class Member input

Incorrect CVAP Data
