
... Petal Fall Declared in District 4...

To comply with the public notice provisions of Section 6984 of the California Code of Regulations pertaining to citrus/bee protection areas, Fresno County Agricultural Commissioner Melissa Cregan announced today that she is officially declaring the <u>end of the citrus bloom period for citrus</u> growing in District 4 beginning at 1:00 a.m., Thursday morning, May 1, 2025.

The declaration of Petal Fall <u>DOES NOT</u> supersede product labeling. All applicators are reminded that they must always read and follow the pesticide product labeling regarding toxicity to bees.

Citrus growers are reminded that applications of Carbaryl are prohibited until complete petal fall.
