TOPIC:

Assessment roll for 2014-2015 increases 5.78% from prior year as real estate

market recovery gains strength

Thanks to the work of dedicated staff, Fresno County Assessor-Recorder Paul Dictos presented a local assessment roll of \$63.859 billion for the 2014-2015 Fiscal Year to Auditor-Controller/Treasurer-Tax Collector Vicki Crow based on the value of all local property as of January 1, 2014. The 5.78% increase in the total roll value equates to approximately \$3.49 billion in increased value from the previous year's roll value. "Fresno County continues to lead the way for the rest of the valley as we move out of the recession", said Dictos.

Most of the municipalities showed an increase in their assessed value: Fresno 6.79%; Clovis 8.65%; Coalinga 3.58%, Firebaugh .266%, Fowler 7.19%, Kerman 5.91%, Kingsburg 4.76%, Orange Cove 3.74%, Parlier 10.9%, Reedley 4.93%, Sanger 4.24%, and Selma 3.52%

Online valuation notices for real property will be available to property owners on July 7, 2014. Notices can be searched by either assessor parcel number or property address at http://assessor.co.fresno.ca.us.

"I encourage property owners to compare their 2014-2015 value notices to their 2013-2014 property tax bills to understand the nature of the change," Dictos said.
