Subject: Quality Management Action Notice replacing News You Can Use.

The purpose of this memo is to provide an update and clarification on the new *Quality Management Action Notice* (QMAN) for the Fresno County Behavioral Health Plan (BHP).

Fresno County BHP previously used the News You Can Use as a method to inform providers about information related to state regulations and policies. Significant changes in the policy and regulatory environment affecting behavioral health services in California prompt a new approach. The *Quality Management Action Notice* (QMAN) has replaced the News You Can Use, effective immediately. The content of QMANs will focus on changes and/or new information related to Behavioral Health Transformation, Behavioral Health Services Act, and/or DBH quality management, performance monitoring, audits, or other important information.

QMANs will communicate local operationalization of quality management efforts, performance monitoring, measure initiation, etc., but are not summaries of the California Department of Healthcare Services Behavioral Health Info Notices (BHINs) or other regulations; QMANs serve as helpful reminders to draw your attention to actions required. All BHP providers remain responsible for reviewing, understanding, and complying with all laws, regulations, and BHINs.

The first two QMANs released on July 1st were revised and replaced with updated versions on 7.17.2026 date; please review the current versions.
