

FAKE MEDICATIONS ALERT

Beware of Potentially **Fatal**
Fentanyl Pills Disguised as REAL PILLS

ATTENTION:

- Fake prescription pills containing fentanyl are being sold on the streets in Fresno County (examples featured in pictures).
- Fentanyl is a powerful opioid that is used for pain.
- Even small amounts of “street fentanyl” can be fatal.
- You should never purchase or ingest medication / prescription drugs that are not prescribed by your doctor.
- **Naloxone**, also known as Narcan, is a reversal drug for opioids and can be obtained from your physician, pharmacies and Community Regional Medical Center.
- If a person encounters someone that is suspected of over dose they should immediately call 911.

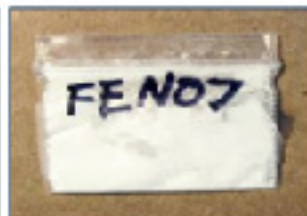
