WHAT IS AN OPIOID?

Opioids are a class of drug used to treat pain. Some examples of opioids are: **codeine**, **hydrocodone**, **oxycodone**, **morphine**, **fentanyl** (and illicitly heroin, “street” fentanyl).

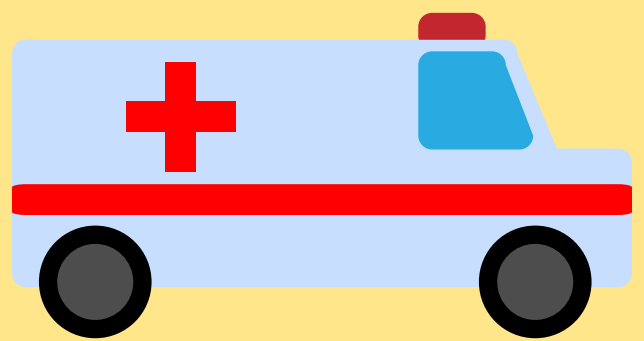


WHAT DO OPIOIDS DO?

Medical doctors use opioids safely for certain conditions they monitor but even then they carry high addiction potential. Even small amounts of fake opioids laced with fentanyl can result in **overdose and death**.

HOW IS OPIOID OVERDOSE TREATED?

Naloxone is an FDA approved drug that reverses the effect of an opioid overdose.
