## Fresno County LAAC Meeting Minutes Thursday, 01/21/2021 2:00 PM

## **Attendance and Introductions**

The meeting held via Microsoft Teams was called to order at 2:00 PM with the following members present virtually: Brandi Orth, Cindy Lee, James Kus, Nysen Armenta, Luis Ojeda, Kamal Kaur, Jennifer Xiong, Marco Rodriguez, Angela Delgado and Silvina Elliott.

### **Review of Minutes**

After introductions were made, Silvina offered a few minutes for everyone to conduct a quick review of the minutes from the last LAAC meeting that took place on September 24, 2020. Without any objections, a motion was brought forward by Cindy to accept the minutes and approved.

#### **Debrief of November Election**

James gave the committee a debrief of the November election. There were 53 vote centers located throughout Fresno County. All 53 locations provided assistance in Spanish, 16 in Hmong, 10 in Punjabi, 4 in Chinese, 2 in Khmer, 2 in Korean, 4 in Lao, 1 in Vietnamese and 1 in Tagalog. There were 5 recorded uses of the Secretary of State provided translation phone service.

Brandi added that every Vote Center was provided a cell phone to be able to connect to translation services as well as translation guides to better assist bilingual voters.

## Debrief of Bilingual Voter Workshops

Silvina provided a debrief on the Bilingual Voter Workshops. For the March 2<sup>nd</sup> election there were 5 language workshops held in Spanish, Hmong, Chinese and Vietnamese on February 13<sup>th</sup> and Tagalog on February 15<sup>th</sup>.

James added, the workshops were recorded and are available for view on the Fresno County Elections website.

## Update on March Election

James informed the committee of the upcoming municipal and special election on March 2<sup>nd</sup>. The election will be in Clovis and Orange Cove. There will be two 10-day Vote Centers opening on February 20<sup>th</sup> and an additional 7 locations will open on February 27<sup>th</sup>. Across the 9 vote centers there will be 1 with Chinese support, 1 with Vietnamese, 1 with Tagalog, 2 with Hmong and all 9 with Spanish support.
