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Upcoming Election changes:

- SB450 Implications
 - 1. Takes effect 2018 for only certain counties
 - 2. Everyone to receive ballots by mail. Regional vote centers for assistance would be established.
 - 3. Voters could visit any Vote Center, and receive their specific precinct ballot.
 - 4. Vote centers would be open 10 days in advance of election.

All committee attendees received demonstration and hands-on experience with the Training Materials – Demo with the TSX (touchscreen) voting devices.
