NOTICE OF CLOSE OF ELECTION ACTIVITIES CONSOLIDATED PRESIDENTIAL PRIMARY ELECTION

The Fresno County Elections office will be ending post-election activities for the March 5, 2024, Consolidated Presidential Primary Election on Friday March 29, 2024. Final voting results will be published to the Fresno County Elections website, VoteFresnoCounty.com, and Certification of the Election results will be transmitted to the California Secretary of State.

Per California Elections Code section 3019, all signature cure letters for signature mis-match envelopes and signature missing envelopes must be returned to the Fresno County Elections department by 5:00pm, two days prior to the Certification of the Election. For the March 5, 2024, Consolidated Presidential Primary Election, the deadline for cure letters to be returned to the department is Wednesday, March 27, 2024, at 5:00pm. No cure letters received after this date and time will be accepted for this election.
