

IMPARTIAL ANALYSIS BY CITY ATTORNEY CITY OF HURON

Measure ____ will appear as a ballot measure for the November 5, 2024 election.

The City Council of the City of Huron is comprised of one elective Mayor and four elected City Council Members. Each City Council Member other than the Mayor currently serves an elected term of four years. The Mayor currently serves a term of two years. The Measure ____ will change the term of office of Mayor from two years to four years. This measure was placed on the ballot by the City Council, the governing body of the City of Huron.

Changing the term of the Mayor's office will maintain the staggered elections of the City Council Members with either the Mayor and one other Council Member; or, three Council Members being elected in each year ending in an even number. This will make the Mayor's term of office equivalent to the City Council Member's terms of office. A "yes" vote on the Measure will cause the term of office of the Mayor to be changed from two to four years.
