FRESNO COUNTY CLERK/REGISTRAR OF VOTERS ANNOUNCES URGENT LIMITED TIME RECRUITMENT FOR ELECTION WORKERS

FRESNO, CA – Fresno County Clerk/Registrar of Voters, James A. Kus, announced that applications for Election Worker and Election Outreach Coordinator have been opened for the November 4, 2025, Statewide Special Election. This recruitment is open now through September 5 and applications must be made using the County of Fresno jobs website at: FresnoCountyJobs.com.

Opportunities are available at geographically diverse locations across the County and include direct support to in-person voting, some basic IT support and office-based activities. Election Workers for this election will be provided paid training, a minimum of 36 hours during the election including overtime, and will be eligible for preferred job opportunities for all elections scheduled in 2026. Applicants who are bilingual in Spanish, Chinese, Hmong, Khmer, Korean, Laos, Punjabi, Tagalog, or Vietnamese are eligible for a pay increase if hired.

Being an Election Worker is an excellent opportunity to give back to your community while building job skills and being fairly compensated for your efforts. High School Juniors and Seniors, as well as college students, are strongly encouraged to apply as Election Worker positions can help to fulfill community service requirements while also providing excellent experience relevant to future applications.
