SUBMITTING ARGUMENTS ON THE CITY OF KINGSBURG
TRANSACTION AND USE TAX MEASURE

Notice is hereby given that the following measure is to be voted on at the City of Kingsburg
municipal election to be held in the City of Kingsburg, on Tuesday, June 5, 2018.

KINGSBURG PUBLIC SAFETY MEASURE: To generate approximately \$940,000 annually
for ten years to hire additional police officers to increase crime suppression and prevention;
bolster firefighter and paramedic staffing levels and 911 emergency services; and restore
and replace out-of-date equipment, shall the City of Kingsburg enact a 1 cent sales tax,
requiring a citizens' oversight committee and annual reporting of expenses, with all funds
generated staying in the City of Kingsburg?

SYNOPSIS OF MEASURE

"To generate approximately \$940,000 annually for ten years to hire additional police
officers to increase crime suppression and prevention; bolster firefighter and paramedic
staffing levels and 911 emergency services; and restore and replace out-of-date
equipment, shall the City of Kingsburg enact a 1 cent sales tax, requiring a citizens'
oversight committee and annual reporting of expenses, with all funds generated staying in
the City of Kingsburg?" This sales tax will be a special tax, meaning revenues raised from
the sales tax will go into a dedicated fund to be used exclusively to pay for police, fire
protection, emergency response services and restoration and replacement of equipment."

Arguments for or against the measure may be submitted to the Fresno County Clerk
/Elections, 2221 Kern St., Fresno, CA 93721, no later than Friday, March 23, 2018 by 5:00
pm. Paper copies of arguments must be submitted with original signatures, as well as by
email at clerk-elections@co.fresno.ca.us in MS Word format. No argument shall exceed
300 words in length. Arguments may be submitted by the legislative body, or any member
or members of the legislative body authorized by that body, or any individual voter who is
eligible to vote on the measure, or bona fide association of citizens, or argument submitted.
If an argument is signed by more than five persons, the names of only the first five persons
signing, determined by the order in which their signatures appear, shall be printed with the
argument.

Only one argument for and one argument against each measure will be selected for
printing and distribution to the voters. Preference and priority in selection will be given in
the order named: (1) The legislative body, or member or members of the legislative body
authorized by that body; (2) The individual voter or bona fide association of citizens, or
combination of voters and associations, who are the bona fide sponsors or proponents of
the measure; (3) Bona fide associations of citizens; (4) Individual voters who are eligible to
vote on the measure. Any argument submitted shall not be changed after March 23, 2018
by 5:00 pm.

ALL ARGUMENTS submitted shall be verified in substantially the following form:
