RE: Initiative Measure for Sales Tax Increase Resolution No. 2407 – Amended Question on Election Ballot

Dear Ms. Orth:

The City of Fowler recently submitted an executed Resolution on August 9, 2018, approving the text of an initiative measure for a proposed sales tax increase for the November 6, 2018 ballot. It was brought to our attention that the word count would exceed 75 words if the title was to be kept in the ballot question.

The following amended question shall be submitted to registered voters of the City of Fowler and shall be printed on the election ballot set forth as follows:

<b>Initiative Measure for Sales Tax Increase</b>	
To generate approximately \$953,000 annually to build a new police station and restore or replace out-of-date police equipment. Revenues will also be used to fix city streets needing repair and to pay escalating pension obligations and other general fund obligations. Shall the City of Fowler enact a 1 cent sales tax, requiring an annual reporting of expenses, with all funds generated staying in the City of Fowler?	YES
