CITY ATTORNEY'S IMPARTIAL ANALYSIS

The City Council of the City of Sanger has placed Measure __ on the November 3, 2020, ballot to ask the City voters to change the term of office for the Mayor from a two-year term to a four-year term.

Existing Law

In 2010, the City voters adopted a measure which provided for the election of four Council Members by district every four years and the election of Mayor on an at-large basis every two years. The measure is codified as an ordinance in the Sanger City Code in Section 2-29.

Proposed Change

Measure __ proposes to amend the Mayor's term of office from a two-year term in office to a four-year term in office. All other terms and conditions for election of the Mayor would remain the same.

The Measure, if approved by the voters, would adopt an ordinance which is a City law. The ordinance would be codified in the Sanger City Code.

If approved by the voters, the Measure would take effect with the election of Mayor at the November 3, 2020 election.

The Measure requires a majority (50% plus 1) of votes cast by City of Sanger voters at the November 3, 2020 election to pass.

A "Yes" vote on the Measure is a vote to approve the ordinance extending the Mayor's term from two years to four years.

A "No" votes on the Measure is a vote against extending the Mayor's term from two years to four years.
