**NOTICE OF DATE FIXED FOR SUBMITTING ARGUMENTS ON THE**  
**CENTRAL UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT GENERAL OBLIGATION**  
**BOND MEASURE**

On August 11, 2020, A NOTICE was printed in The Fresno Bee that incorrectly stated the argument date deadline as Monday, August 21, 2020.

THEREFORE, THE CORRECTED NOTICE IS GIVEN to all qualified electors in the Central Unified School District, that on Tuesday, November 3, 2020, there will be submitted to the voters the following measure:

To provide quality schools including a comprehensive high school and new elementary school; improve student safety/school security; renovate existing classrooms and schools; upgrade technology infrastructure, and create local construction jobs shall Central Unified School District's measure authorizing \$120 million in bonds be adopted, with legal interest rates, estimated levies averaging less than 6¢ per \$100 of assessed value, raising \$6.8 million annually to repay bonds through maturity, annual audits, citizen oversight and all funds benefitting Central schools?

Arguments for or against the measure may be submitted to the Fresno County Clerk/Elections, 2221 Kern St., Fresno, CA 93721, no later than **Friday, August 21, 2020**, by 5:00 pm. Paper copies of arguments must be submitted with original signatures, as well as by email to [clerk-elections@fresnocountyca.gov](mailto:clerk-elections@fresnocountyca.gov) in MS Word format. No argument shall exceed 300 words in length. Arguments may be submitted by the legislative body, or any member or members of the legislative body authorized by that body, or any individual voter who is eligible to vote on the measure, or bona fide association of citizens, or any combination of voters and associations. If an argument is signed by more than five persons, the names of only the first five persons signing, determined by the order in which their signatures appear, shall be printed with the argument.

Only one argument for and one argument against each measure will be selected for printing and distribution to the voters. Preference and priority in selection will be given in the order named: (1) The legislative body, or member or members of the legislative body authorized by that body; (2) The individual voter or bona fide association of citizens, or combination of voters and associations, who are the bona fide sponsors or proponents of the measure; (3) Bona fide associations of citizens; (4) Individual voters who are eligible to vote on the measure. Any argument submitted shall not be changed after August 21, 2020 by 5:00 pm.

ALL ARGUMENTS submitted shall be verified in substantially the following form:
