Four years ago, Central voters approved Measure C, for \$87.3 Million.

In 2016, the School Board told us with that bond they would build a new high school, elementary school and could address specific projects listed for other schools.

The bond proposal in March 2020, specifically named 22 Central Unified schools on the Bond Project List. For this November election, these 22 school names have been removed from the Project List. **Why?**

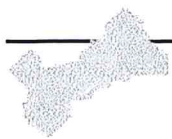
It's as if the Board wants us to give them \$120 Million of tax money with no questions asked.
