

Ballot Argument in Favor of Measure _ - Mendota General Transactions and Use Tax

With the City of Mendota’s limited financial resources and rapid growth, it is becoming challenging to properly maintain, improve, and expand its services and infrastructure for the benefit of the community. Also, it is oftentimes difficult for the City of Mendota to compete with larger cities for financial resources to fund these crucial items due its size and location. Despite these ongoing difficulties, there continues to be a vital need to expand recreational facilities for Mendota residents and to improve the deteriorating condition of important infrastructure, such as our roads.

The approval of Measure _ will result in much-needed funds that would go a long way towards enhancing the safety and quality of life of the Mendota community for years to come.
