

Measure M is a critical step forward for improving the quality of life for our city's 20,000 veterans and our Fresno neighborhoods in the process, all with public oversight and financial audits to ensure that our resources are well-utilized.

As previously mentioned, Measure M focuses on three overarching goals:

1. Improving old and building new Veterans facilities
2. Investing in social, mental health, and job training services for veterans
3. Eliminating veteran homelessness through strategic investments in bridge housing

With new revenues, the City of Fresno aims to improve Fresno's pre-existing veterans facilities, such as the Veterans Memorial Auditorium, VFW posts, and American Legion Hall.

We will also look to build a brand-new Veterans Center, a combination of Memorial Hall, museum, and veterans resource and entrepreneurship center.

This Veterans Center will ensure that we have a place to honor our fighting men and women, teach the next generation of their selfless service to our country, give returning veterans a central location to connect and grow as they return to civilian life, and serve as a hub for the various social, mental health, and job services funded by Measure M.

To ensure that these goals are met, Measure M includes safeguards for taxpayers. Expenditures are subject to annual audits reviewed by an independent Veterans Commission.

In short, Measure M delivers badly-needed upgrades to our veteran facilities, improves key services for our veterans and keeps them off the streets, all with safeguards for our tax dollars.
