Fresno County will benefit from Measure E. It's a tiny tax that adds one penny to a \$5 purchase, yet it creates 20,000 jobs and generates up to \$3.72 billion in economic stimulus over 20 years.

Measure E requires tough fiscal accountability. A Citizen's Oversight Committee must publish an annual audit and hold open public meetings to determine how these funds will be allocated.

Measure E will ensure that our university has the financial support it needs to achieve world-class excellence without competing for limited State resources.

Two-thirds of the money raised by Measure E must be spent on academics. No more than one-third can be used for athletics and gender equity is a priority.

Measure E will expand access to programs such as: nursing, criminology, agriculture and engineering, and will modernize campus buildings constructed decades ago including new academic buildings, enhance accessibility and safety, expand resources for veterans and provide scholarships for Fresno County students.

63% of California State University, Fresno's 2022 graduates are the first in their family to earn a bachelor's degree. Measure E expands those opportunities for more Fresno County families.
