IMPORTANT:

- The **FIRST PUBLICATION MUST BE WITHIN 45 DAYS** of filing of the Fictitious Name Statement and/or Abandonment (Business and Professions Code Section 17917). It must be published for four weeks in a row, at least once a week (CA Government Code Section 6064). **There are no extensions to the 45 day time limit under any circumstances.**
- Publication deadlines vary for each newspaper. Please contact newspapers in advance.
- If the publication requirements are not met, the FBN Statement will be inactivated and removed from the index. You will then be required to file a new FBN Statement along with the filing fee.
- Your FBN is good for 5 years. If you make any change to the information on your original statement, other than a change of residence address for owner, a new FBN Statement must be filed and published. If your FBN expires and is not renewed within the 40 day grace period a new filing and publication will be required.
