NICOLAS ALCALA SENTENCED TO LIFE IN PRISON FOR GANG RELATED MURDER AND ATTEMPTED MURDER

Senior Deputy District Attorney Robert Mangano and Senior Investigator David Trevino are pleased to announce that today, October 14, 2015, Nicolas Alcala was sentenced to 82 years to life in prison for the gang related murder of Pedro Aispuro and attempted murder of Salvador Solis.

On June 4, 2012, the defendant, a local gang member, fired a handgun at Salvador Solis while outside of a bar in the City of Huron. Pedro Aispuro was struck by the gunfire and died.

Mr. Alcala was found guilty by a jury in July of the murder of Mr. Aispuro and attempted murder of Mr. Solis, both with the use of a firearm. The jury also found that the crimes were gang related.

The Honorable Judge Denise Whitehead sentenced the defendant today to a term of 82 years to life in the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation.

Senior Deputy District Attorney Mangano would like to thank the members of the Fresno County Sheriff's Office, and especially Homicide Detective Donna Davis, for their hard work and dedication to obtaining justice for the victims in this case.
