DISTRICT ATTORNEY FILES NUMEROUS AUTO THEFT AND BURGLARY CHARGES AGAINST JENNIFER CARLTON AND THOMAS CUMMINGS FOR VETERANS DAY AUTO THEFTS FROM VETERAN

The Fresno County District Attorney's Office has filed criminal charges against Jennifer Carlton (38, of Kerman) and Thomas Cummings (34, of Fresno) relating to the Veterans Day thefts of 2 vehicles from a barn in Kerman belonging to retired Lieutenant Colonel Donald Klein.

Jennifer Carlton and Thomas Cummings have each been charged with felony counts of auto theft and burglary for the thefts of the Chevy Bel-Air and the Chevy El Camino on November 11th. They have also charged with other unrelated crimes of auto theft, burglary, possession of stolen property, and identity theft.

The defendants are currently in custody at the Fresno County Jail. They are scheduled for Arraignment in the Fresno County Superior Court on Wednesday, November 25, 2015.
