DISTRICT ATTORNEY FILES ANIMAL CRUELTY CHARGES AGAINST CODY HIGH

The Fresno County District Attorney's Office has filed criminal charges against Cody High (24, of Fresno).

Cody High has been charged with one felony count of Cruelty to an Animal, as well as 1 misdemeanor count of Giving False Information to a Police Officer, and 1 misdemeanor count of Possession of Injection/Ingestion Device.

The defendant is currently in custody at the Fresno County Jail. The defendant faces a potential sentence of up to three years in custody if convicted of the charges.

He is scheduled for Arraignment in Department 34 of the Fresno County Superior Court on Wednesday, January 20, 2016.
