DISTRICT ATTORNEY FILES ATTEMPTED MURDER CHARGES AGAINST HARRY GORDON FOR THE WEEKEND SHOOTING OF HIS ESTRANGED WIFE

The Fresno County District Attorney's Office has filed criminal charges against Harry Gordon (64, of Fresno) for the weekend shooting of his estranged wife.

The shooting took place outside of a home Friday night in Northeast Fresno. Mr. Gordon was arrested that night at the scene.

Harry Gordon has been charged with one felony count of Attempted Murder, and one felony count Corporal Injury to a Spouse, as well as enhancements for using a firearm in the commission of the crimes and causing great bodily injury.

The defendant is currently in custody at the Fresno County Jail. He faces a potential life sentence if convicted.

He is scheduled for Arraignment in Department 96 of the Fresno County Superior Court on Wednesday, February 3, 2016.
