CRIMINAL THREAT CHARGE FILED AGAINST EDWARD HANNAH FOR CENTRAL HIGH SCHOOL PROM THREAT

Edward Hannah (18, of Fresno) has been charged in a Felony Complaint for the May 12th social media threat directed at Central High School's prom, the Fresno County District Attorney's Office has announced.

The Complaint alleges that the defendant committed the felony crime of Criminal Threats [P.C. § 422].

If convicted of the charge, Mr. Hannah faces a sentence of up to three (3) years in prison.

Mr. Hannah is currently in custody at the Fresno County Jail. He is scheduled to be arraigned in Department 34 of the Fresno County Superior Court on Wednesday, May 16, 2018, at 8:30 a.m.
