FRESNO COUNTY DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S OFFICE FILES CHILD PORNOGRAPHY, SEXUAL EXPLOITATION OF A CHILD & GUN CHARGES AGAINST TODD MUMMA

Today, July 9, 2020, the Fresno County District Attorney's Office filed two (2) felony counts and one (1) misdemeanor count against Todd Eric Mumma, age 57, of Fresno. Mumma is accused of possessing child pornography, sexual exploitation of a child and possessing an illegal assault weapon.

It is alleged that Mumma surreptitiously videotaped an underaged victim and created still photographs from these videos and that these videos and photographs meet the legal definition of child pornography. Additionally, during the execution of a search warrant at Mumma's residence, an illegal assault rifle belonging to Mumma was also found.

As a result of the investigation conducted by the Fresno County Sheriff's Office and the Central California Internet Crimes against Children Task Force (ICAC), Mumma has been charged with one count of felony P.C. 311.11(a) (possession of child pornography), one count of misdemeanor P.C. 311.3(a) (sexual exploitation of a child), and one count of felony P.C. 30605(a) (possession of an assault weapon).

If convicted of all charges, Mumma faces a maximum sentence of four (4) years and eight (8) months in state prison.

Mumma is scheduled to be arraigned on the charges on Tuesday, July 14th, 2020.
