Due to personal and professional relationships, Fresno County District Attorney Lisa Smittcamp has declared a conflict of interest in the pending domestic violence case against Central Unified School District Superintendent Andrew Alvarado. Accordingly, the Madera County District Attorney's Office will review the case for criminal charges. Should the Madera County District Attorney choose to pursue criminal charges, a Madera County prosecutor will specially appear in the Fresno County Superior Court to process and handle the case to its conclusion.
