Richard Bradberry Sentenced to 65 Years to Life in Prison for Sexual Assaults on Four Teenage Boys

Today, June 28, 2022, Richard David Bradberry (58, of Clovis) was sentenced to 65 years to life in prison for sexually assaulting multiple teenage boys. Bradberry's sentenced was handed down after he was found guilty of all counts and allegations following a jury trial that concluded on May 31, 2022, in the Fresno Superior Court.

Bradberry was arrested by the Clovis Police Department in July 2019. Evidence presented at trial showed that Bradberry befriended these minors and gained their trust by allowing them to play video games and smoke in his home. Shortly after, Bradberry began to sexually assault these minors whose ages ranged from 10 years old to 16 years old.

This case was successfully prosecuted by Deputy District Attorney Adam Christopherson with our Sexual Assault and Child Abuse Unit. Mr. Christopherson was assisted by District Attorney Senior Investigator Julie Skamel from the Fresno County District Attorney's Bureau of Investigations.
