## **Defendant Charged with Murder of Unhoused Individual**

The Fresno County District Attorney's Office has filed charges against Ian Patrick Scarborough (33, of Fresno) for the murder of 61-year-old Billy Cleveland Carrow, Jr. of Fresno.

It is alleged that on October 17<sup>th</sup>, 2022, in the area of San Marcos and G Streets, Scarborough stabbed Carrow, Jr. multiple times, including once in the neck causing his death. Carrow, Jr. was an unhoused individual living in the area.

The Felony Complaint filed in the Superior Court alleges that Scarborough committed:

- One (1) Count of MURDER [Penal Code §187(a)]
- One (1) Enhancement of PERSONAL USE OF A DANGEROUS OR DEADLY WEAPON [Penal Code §12022(b)(1)]

If convicted of all charges and allegations, Scarborough faces a sentence of 26 years to life in prison.

Scarborough was arrested by the Fresno Police Department on October 21<sup>st</sup>, 2022, in Fresno, CA, and thereafter booked into the Fresno County Jail. Scarborough's arraignment is scheduled for October 26<sup>th</sup>, 2022, at 8:30 a.m. in Department 33 of the Fresno County Superior Court.
