CALIFORNIA VICTIM COMPENSATION PROGRAM

You may be eligible if you are...

- Injured, threatened with physical injury, or suffer emotional injury as a direct result of a violent crime
- In need of financial assistance for medical, mental health, funeral/burial and/ or other crime-related expenses
- Certain family members or loved ones who suffered an economic loss resulting from an injury to, or death of, a victim of a violent crime
- A child residing in a home where domestic violence or the abuse of another child occurs
- A "Good Samaritan" who is injured or suffers loss while assisting a victim during a crime
- A witness to a crime, under 18 years old, and not related to the victim
