



**Fresno County Department of Public Health  
Rural Mobile Health Program - Event Criteria**

**A. Target Population**

The Rural Mobile Health program aims to provide no cost medical services to the following groups:

- 1. Agricultural Workers in Fresno County:**
  - a. Individuals employed in agricultural settings that are in Fresno County, including farms and related facilities.
- 2. Individuals Living in the Rural Areas within Fresno County:**
  - a. Individuals residing in the rural communities of Fresno County, outside the Fresno and Clovis city limits.
  - b. Prioritize rural areas with limited access to healthcare resources.

**B. Location**

When organizing mobile health events, staff from medical partners are expected to adhere to the following:

- 1. Rural Areas**
  - a. Location of events should be held in rural areas of Fresno County and not within the Fresno and Clovis city limits.
  - b. Rural Mobile Health events are also to take place in areas that are easily accessible to the community (e.g. community centers, parks, churches).
- 2. Agricultural Workplaces**
  - a. Agricultural workplaces located in Fresno County.
