GRADING AND DRAINAGE PLAN SUBMITTAL REQUIREMENTS FOR NON-LAND USE RELATED APPLICATIONS

While paper plans are still accepted, electronic plans in pdf format are prefered.

- 1. A minimum of three (3) sets of the Grading and Drainage Plan drawn to **scale** on minimum 24" x 36" US Architectural Drawing Size ARCH D
 - (Plans <u>must</u> be folded to 9" x 12" maximum size with lower right corner of plans at front. If there is a proposed improvement within the County right-of way, a minimum of 5 sets shall be required.)
- 2. The Grading Plan Check Fee shall be based on the volume of excavation or fill, whichever is greater:
 - a. If grading volume is less than 1,000 cubic yards, the grading plan check fee is \$416.00.
 - b. If grading volume is more than 1,000 cubic yards, the grading plan check fee is \$467.00.
 - c. If grading volume exceeds 10,000 cubic yards, contact Grading Engineer for the required grading plan check fee.
- 3. A completed, signed and stamped Grading and Drainage Plan Checklist
- 4. The required basin storage capacity calculations and proposed basin design capacity calculations, if applicable (if not shown on plan)
- 5. Soils Report from a licensed Geotechnical Engineer for all grading in excess of 1,000 cu. yd. and/or as required
- Retaining wall detail and approved copy of calculations, if applicable.
- 7. Hydrology & Hydraulics Calculations for proposed storm drain pipes/culverts, if applicable
- 8. NOI and SWPPP, if applicable
 - (They shall be required if the commencement of any construction activities will disturb 1.0 acre or more of area.)
- 9. Previous checkprints from Development Engineering Section and/or Road Maintenance and Operations Division except for first submittals
