- DBE forms are due by 4pm on the 5th calendar day after the bid opening. Three
 of the forms are required for all contractors (15-G, 9-I, 12-B), but the Good Faith
 Effort (GFE) form (15-H) is required if the Total Claimed DBE Participation
 (Exhibit 15-G Construction Contract DBE Commitment) does not meet the
 Contract DBE Goal. If your DBE commitment meets the goal by a small margin, a
 GFE is recommended.
- Good Faith Efforts for projects over two million dollars are evaluated by Caltrans. For projects under two million dollars the GFE is evaluated by County staff.
- When filling out the DBE forms, the "Local Agency" is the "County of Fresno"

Bidding Logistics with the County

- Generally, the Department of Industrial Relations (DIR) registration must be up to date and paid at the time of bid, however, there is a notification on the DIR website stating a *temporary* pause of enforcement, so if you have a DIR registration, please provide it. If not, we will not prevent any contractors or subcontractors from being awarded a contract due to your inability to register with the DIR.

- CARB certificates for the prime contractor are required at the time of the bid opening. Subcontractors' certificates are due within five (5) calendar days of the bid opening. These are the certificates that are provided by DOORS, not the Truck and Bus Regulations.
- Subcontractor details are required at the time of bid opening pursuant Section 1725.5 of the Labor Code and Section 4104 of the California Public Contract Code. All the other requested information is due within 24 hours after the bid opening and may be emailed to DesignServices@fresnocountyca.gov
- Insurance limits and requirements are listed in the Sample Agreement of the Bid Book.

Description of the Project

The work to be done consists, in general, of reconstructing approximately 1.5 miles of Jensen Avenue from West Avenue to Fig Avenue (also known as MLK Boulevard). The road will be reconstructed using a Full-Depth Reclamation with Cement method. The road work includes construction of new curb ramps, adjusting sewer manholes, signage and striping, and other miscellaneous items. A new ductile iron water pipeline will also be installed, replacing an existing asbestos water pipeline to be abandoned in place. Coordination with City of Fresno Public Utilities Department will be necessary to arrange the tie-in to existing system. The pipe replacement also involves installation of new water meters, fire hydrants, valves, and other appurtenant work. Some Fresno Metropolitan Flood Control District (FMFCD) master storm drain facilities shall also be installed as part of the work.

Advertisements for DBEs, written solicitations sent to all qualified firms, offers of assistance, and follow-up phone calls support an effective outreach campaign.



Lastly, the evaluator considers the rejected DBE bids and the reasons for the rejection. For example,

- Did the bidder reject a marginally higher
 DBE bid that could have allowed the bidder to meet the goal?
- Did the bidder reject a DBE bid that another bidder accepted?
- Did the bidder forgo a reasonable bid to do the work himself?

A "yes" answer may suggest an inadequate goodfaith effort.

NOTIFICATION PAUSING ENFORCEMENT OF PW SYSTEM REQUIREMENTS - 1771.4(a)(3)

This is to notify interested parties that enforcement of contractor registration requirements as well as the requirement to submit electronic certified payroll records (eCPRs) to the Labor Commissioner using DIR's online eCPR system is temporarily paused for the period of 12 months, which runs from 6/22/2024 through 6/22/2025.

Awarding Agencies will not be penalized for hiring unregistered contractors nor need to withhold funds due to a contractor's inability to register nor provide eCPRs due to system issues. Additionally, Awarding Bodies and Prime Contractors should not prevent contractors from bidding or working on a Public Works jobs as a result of their inability to register or submit certified payroll due to system issues.

Once the stay of enforcement is lifted, contractors will not be required to retroactively submit eCPRs nor will they be required to retroactively register.

It is important to note that the requirement to submit eCPRs is separate and distinct from the obligation in Labor Code section 1776 which is unaffected by this notice.

The Labor Commissioner recommends that awarding bodies and general contractors consider this
