The project proposes to construct, operate, maintain, and decommission a battery energy storage facility on approximately 260 acres of private land in western Fresno County. The project would store up to 3 gigawatts of energy and would consist of modular battery enclosures, an on-site collector substation, power conversion systems, and ancillary equipment. It would include an approximately 0.5-mile long, 500-kilovolt overhead transmission line between the project site and PG&E's existing Gates Substation and modifications within PG&E's existing Midway substation in Kern County.
