


Chart I: The data represents the type of child maltreatment referrals from January 2024 through March of 2024. Source: SafeMeasures.




Chart II: The data represents the total number of child maltreatment allegations from January 2024 through March 2024. Source: SafeMeasures.




Chart III: The data represents referral outcomes from January 2024 through March 2024. Source: SafeMeasures.




Chart IV: The data represents the number of cases by task area from January 2024 through March 2024. Source: SafeMeasures.





Chart V: The data shows a total case count by ethnicity from January 2024 through March 2024. Source: SafeMeasures.




Chart VII: The data shows the sequential number of placements for youth in foster care from initial entry to the end of placement from January 2024 through March 2024. Source: SafeMeasures.




Chart VIII: Placements by facility type for youth placed in-county from January 2024 through March 2024. Source: SafeMeasures.




Chart IX: Placements by facility type for youth placed out of county from January 2024 through March 2024. Source: SafeMeasures.




Chart X: Placements by facility type for youth placed in-count versus out of county from January 2024 through March 2024. Source: SafeMeasures.




Chart XI: The data show out of state placements from January 2024 through March 2024. Source: SafeMeasures.










Chart XV: The data show the average length of stay for youth using Mod-C housing from January 2024 through March 2024. Source: CWS Program Staff (internal tracking).




Chart XVI: The data shows the totals for each reason of entry into Mod-C from January 2024 through March 2024. Source: CWS Program Staff (internal tracking).
