**Training Schedule**

**2023**

**JANUARY – NIGHT SHOOT QUALIFICATION – RANGE 2 (2 HOURS)**

January is the BOI's annual night shoot handgun qualification month. Investigators shoot in low-light or no light conditions. Investigators practice using flashlights or gun mounted lights while shooting as well. Investigators work on weapon manipulations in low-light or no light situations. This includes re-loading of their weapons.

**FEBRUARY – STATIC, BARRICADE / OFF-HAND SHOOTING – RANGE 2 (4 HOURS)**

Investigators shoot their weapons from a static line position, followed by shooting from a barricaded position. Investigators will shoot from the left and right sides of the barricade. Investigators will shoot their weapons using their "weak" or "support" hand.

**MARCH – STRATEGIC COMMUNICATIONS (ONLINE) & INJURED HAND/ARM SHOOTING – RANGE 2 (4 HOURS)**

Investigators will receive online instruction on communication. This is a POST mandated class.

As a follow-up to the February range training, investigators will shoot using their "weak" or "support" hand in the event that their "strong" hand/arm is injured in an accident or a shooting incident. Investigators will also work on how to load their weapons in the event of an injury to one of their hands/arms.

**APRIL – SHOOTING WHILE MOVING – RANGE 2 (4 HOURS)**

Investigators will receive instruction on how to shoot while moving from one location to another.

**MAY – WEAPON INSPECTIONS / QUALIFICATIONS – RANGE 2 (4 HOURS)**

Range instructors conduct an annual inspection of all issued handguns. Investigators will complete a qualification course for their duty weapons. JUNE – POSITIONAL SHOOTING TRAINING – RANGE 2 (4 HOURS)

**JUNE – POST MANDATED EVOC / DRIVERS TRAINING – FPD FACILITY – (4 HOURS)**

Investigators must complete a POST designated slow and high speed driving course. Instruction is provided by POST certified Driver Training Instructors.

**JULY – BACK-UP / OFF-DUTY WEAPONS QUALIFICATIONS – RANGE 2 (1 HOUR)**

Investigators are required by policy to shoot and qualify with their back-up/off-duty weapons if different than their duty weapons. This is done annually.

**AUGUST – SHOTGUN TRAINING / CLEANING OF SHOTGUNS – RANGE 2 (4 HOURS)**

Investigators will shoot a shotgun qualification course. Investigators will shoot both double 00 buckshot and slug ammunition.

**SEPTEMBER – SHOOTING FROM VEHICLES - RANGE 2 (4 HOURS)**

Investigators will receive instruction on shooting from a stationary vehicle.

**OCTOBER – TAC FIREARMS – RANGE 2 (4 HOURS)**

Investigators receive both in class lecture and outdoor firearms training that is mandated by POST. This four hour instruction will fulfill POST TACTICAL FIREARM PSP MANDATES for this training cycle.

**NOVEMBER – FIREARMS QUALIFICATION – RANGE 2 (2 HOURS)**

Investigators will shoot a handgun qualification course.

**DECEMBER – NO TRAINING MONTH**
