

| Within 14 days, plan, assist client, stabilize excessive behaviors, and provide tools for successful interaction | For discharges between 1/1/2016-3/31/2016, the Average Length-of-Stay was 21.5 days. By providing an alternative to traditional psychiatric care through collaboration, empowerment, a healing environment, as well as the use of tools such as medication evaluation, behavior assessment and short-term treatment planning, Exodus was able to reduce the Average Length-of-Stay to 15.7 day for discharges between 4/1/2016-6/30/2016. Exodus is in a good position to achieve the outcome goal of 14 days by Fiscal Year 2016-2017. |
